Towards positivity and optimism....

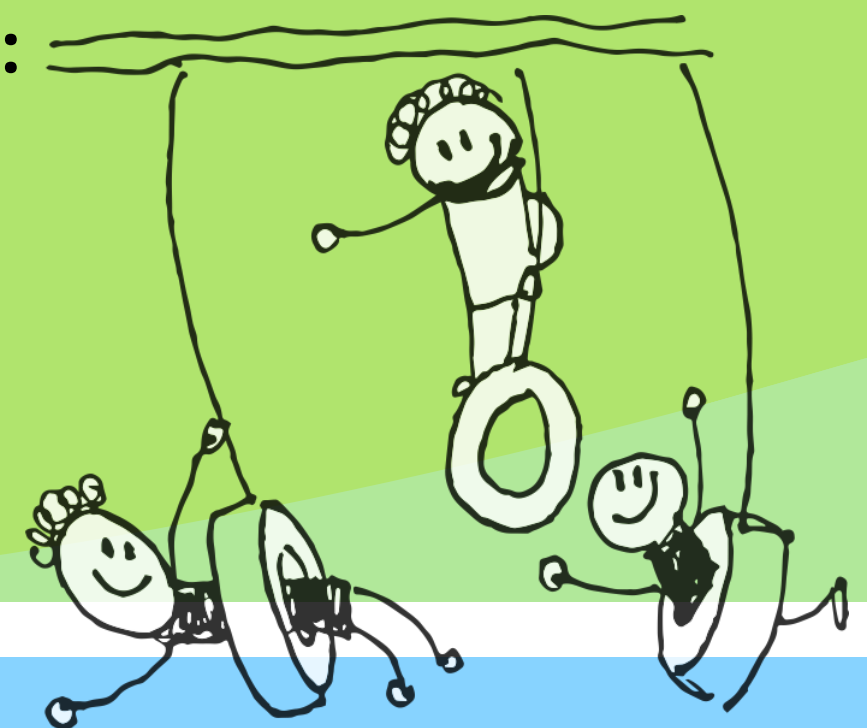

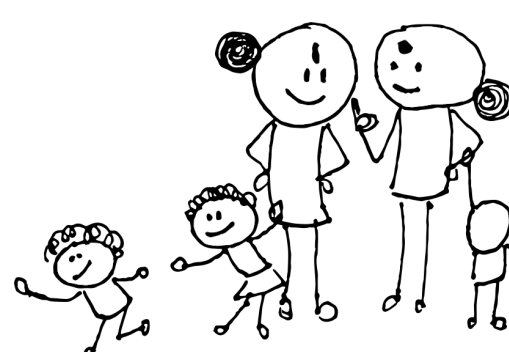
